

Policy Development, Adoption, Revision

1. Policy may be set or revised at a regular meeting of the Board by a vote of a majority of the directors.
2. Normally, policies will receive readings at two consecutive meetings prior to being adopted. However, the Board may waive this requirement in an emergency situation, or in instances where policy changes are considered routine or editorial in nature.
3. The Board shall notify employees and others affected by the adoption or revision of policies that such adoptions or revisions are under consideration.
4. Any policy not established by law may be temporarily suspended by the Board when, in its consideration, such action is in the best interest of the Board, a citizen, staff member or child. All such actions shall be presented to the Board for consideration at its next regular meeting.
5. Proposals for policy additions or revisions may originate from any Board director, staff member or person outside of High Desert Education Service District. Whenever practical, all proposals should be referred to the superintendent prior to formal presentation to the Board.
