

Psychological Services

Psychological services are offered to component school districts in order to assist them with the tasks of assessing students' disabling conditions and serving the needs of students with emotional disabilities. These services shall include testing of referred students, participation of ESD staff members in building-level multidisciplinary team decisions, providing consultation and training to teachers and providing clinical services to individual students and groups of students.

In providing services, no psychological services staff member shall offer services beyond his/her training and/or competence, or engage in practices which violate laws, rules or professional standards. The staff member will draw to the attention of the superintendent any requests for services which seem to fall into aforementioned categories.
