

Relations with Government Agencies

Whenever a law officer wishes to confer with or question a student at the school, the administrator or his/her designee shall be present at the meeting and the student's parents shall be notified of the meeting, preferably in advance.

A student may be removed from school by a law officer, if the student is under arrest or if the officer has a court order; or an authorized representative of the State Office for Services to Children and Families.

Outside agencies may deliver subpoenas and warrants to students in the presence of an administrator.
