5	Physically hurtful or Threatening Behavior	<p>Student: " These are behaviors that are against the law. For example, hitting another person, touching another student-when they don't want to be touched. You can get suspended from school and maybe even arrested for this kind of behavior."</p> <p>Other People:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Feeling: Scared, mad, angry, upset ● Thinking: Really bad thoughts, Stay away from her
4	Scary Behavior	<p>Student: "This behavior is like staring at a student, following a student, swearing at a student, being verbally aggressive-continuing to talk AT student even when they say "NO".</p> <p>Other People:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Feeling: Uncomfortable, scared, mad, frustrated ● Thinking: Bad thoughts, stay away from her
3	Odd Behavior	<p>Student: "This behavior makes other people feel uncomfortable. It includes sitting too close to people, calling students name a lot, expressing that you like them. This is harassing behavior."</p> <p>Other People:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Feeling: Uncomfortable, annoyed, mad, embarrassed ● Thinking: Weird thoughts, stay away from her
2	Reasonable Behavior	<p>Student: "This type of behavior is like working with a group in class or being a part of a school function (dance, game). People are getting to know one another and asking questions like "How are you?", "How was your Day?", "What did you do this weekend?"</p> <p>Other People:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Feeling: safe and calm. ● Thinking: Good thoughts
1	Informal Social Behavior	<p>Student: "This is like waving to someone or smiling to someone in the hallway at school. You just say "hi" and keep on walking. This is OK and how most people first notice each other."</p> <p>Other People:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Feeling: safe and calm ● Thinking: Good thoughts
