

# Playing Games



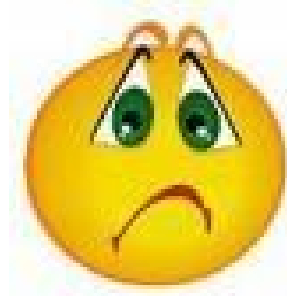
Playing games can be a lot of fun. I like games.

I like winning games. If I win a game, I can also win a friend if I show good sportsmanship.



## Sportsmanship means:

- Do not brag or show off that you won. This makes others feel bad.
  - Say, "Good game."
- If the others are upset because they lost, remind them that it is only a game and they might win next time.

I may sometimes lose games. I can say to myself,  
"It's only a game, there will be other games."

If I lose a game I can also say, " although I lost the game, I can win a friendship which is more important, by showing good sportsmanship.



To show good sportsmanship after I lose a game I can:

- Say, "Congratulations!"
  - Say, "Good game!"
- Say, "You played a good game."
- Shake hands and help friend put away the game or materials.



It's better to win friends than win every game. Friends are important to me and I want to keep them by having good sportsmanship!
