## Emergency and First Aid

Through its safety and health program, the district will attempt to prevent accidents by assuring safe working and learning environments.

In case of sudden illness or injury to a student or staff member, first aid will be given by district staff and medical assistance will be summoned as necessary. Further medical attention to students is the parents' or guardians' responsibility, or of someone the parents or guardians designate in case of emergency.

All sudden illness and injuries, including self-administered first aid, are to be reported immediately to the district safety officer, followed by a written report to be filed with the district safety officer. Written reports will be filed on all accidents occurring on district premises, or involving students or staff who may be elsewhere on school business. Reports will cover property damages, as well as personal injury.

In each facility, procedures for handling health emergencies will be established and made known to staff. Appropriate first-aid equipment will be placed in every facility. All employees are expected to know where first-aid supplies are kept in their work areas. Designated employees in each facility shall hold a current first-aid card.

As a part of the district safety and health program, each facility supervisor will conduct or cause to have conducted fire drills and other emergency drills in accordance with provisions of Oregon law.
