## **Special Education - Participation in Regular Education Programs**

The ESD ensures that to the maximum extent appropriate, children/students with disabilities, including children/students in public or private institutions or other care facilities are educated with children/students who are nondisabled.

Special classes, separate schooling or other removal of children/students with disabilities from the regular educational environment occurs only if the nature or severity of the disability is such that education in regular classes with the use of supplementary aids and services cannot be achieved satisfactorily. A child/student with a disability is not to be removed from education in age-appropriate regular classroom solely because of needed modifications in the general curriculum.
