ESD staff are encouraged to participate in research and experimentation in the development and improvement of education. Staff who propose to engage in research during the work day or use High Desert Education Service District (HDESD) resources or students will submit a proposal to the superintendent for approval prior to commencing such research. If the study results in material that would be useful to other employees, it is recommended that it be made available for distribution through the ESD. For the protection of all concerned, privacy rights of students or other individuals involved in research projects must be protected.

Research that is conducted by or for a non-HDESD individual or organization must be approved by the superintendent.
